Our SEND-trained team carries out the eye test using methods suited to your child, in their familiar environment.

Parents/carers are welcome to attend.

Comprehensive Assessment



We assess vision, eye health, eye movements, focusing, binocular vision, functional vision and whether glasses are needed.

Eye drops may be used (if needed and consented) to fully examine the back of the eye.
