### Creative and exploratory play

**Focus:** Create a leaf collage, make a hedgehog house.

**Equipment:** leaves, sticks, pine cones and conkers, acorns.

Possible paper, glue and paint.

The focus will be to create a collection or collage of the natural materials that you have found, or to help create a safe space for a hedgehog to hibernate.

**Or you could try:** Halloween crafts, as we get closer to the 'spooky' season, explore pumpkins, make spider webs or explore with torches in the dark.

#### **What can you see in your garden?**

Can you see/experience what the weather is like? What Autumn colours objects can you see/collect? Can you collect any autumn leaves to make a collage or can you do leaf/pine cone prints? Can you see any animals getting ready for winter: hedgehogs, squirrels etc.
